Discuss the relationship between the American physical environment and changes in the law that occurred in America from colonial times to the Civil War (approximately), with examples.

II.

Discuss the interrelationship of technological change, economic institutions, and legal institutions in the United States, with examples.

III.

"The instruments of legal change are fictions, equity, and legislation." -- Maine. Discuss the applicability of Maine's statement to legal change in the United States from the Revolution to 1890 (approximately), with examples of each.

IV.

"Trial lawyers, judges, academic writers and even laymen play roles in changing the law." Discuss, with examples of each.
