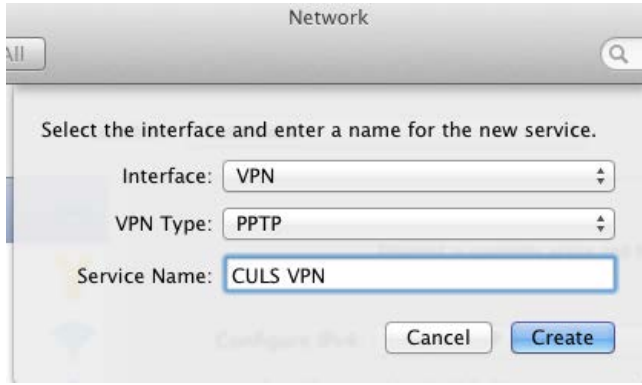
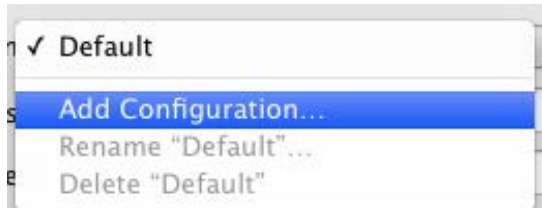


Mac OS X VPN Setup Instructions

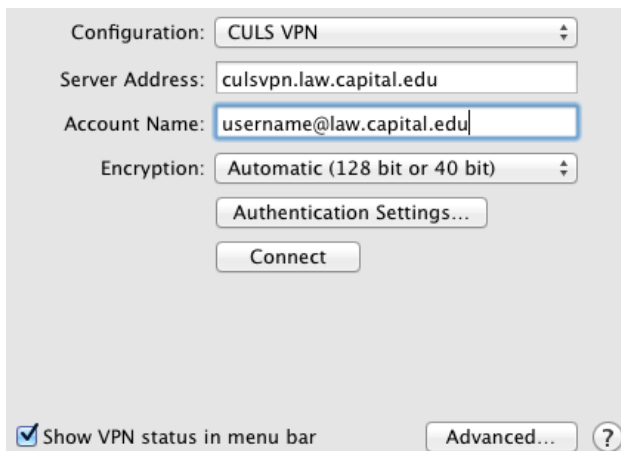
Open up System Preferences and click on Network. Click on the + button right above the lock in the lower left corner. Select VPN for the Interface and PPTP for the VPN Type. type in CULS VPN for the Service Name.



Next to Configuration select Add Configuration... For the Name section type in CULS VPN.



After you have typed in "culsvpn.law.capital.edu" without the quotes in the Server Address box and your full email address in the Account Name box you will want to check the box next to Show VPN status in menu bar. That will make it easier to connect to the VPN for future use.



Accessing your User Drive N:

All faculty and staff at Capital University Law School have an N: drive just for their files. When connecting with VPN the N: drive will not appear automatically.

To connect to the N: drive on your Mac follow this procedure:

- Click on Finder and then click on Go. From there select Connect to Server...
- Type in what is shown in the picture below replacing “departmentname” with either faculty\$ or staff\$ and “username” with your username which is everything before the @ symbol in your email address.
