Then when you get to Civil Procedure Rules in Spring 2014 you can purchase a cheap FRCP book (I recommend you order NITA Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, Publisher NITA, available through LexisNexis, ISBN: 978-1-601561640. I selected this version because it is small, cheap (\$20) and easy to flip through.)</p> <p>o Option 2: This semester, purchase a big combination RULES/STATUTE book - for instance -- Foundation Press, Federal Rules of Civil Procedure 2013 ISBN 978-1-60930-311-2. This is more expensive (\$46) and annoyingly heavy, but has almost all you need for both courses.</p> <p>o It’s your choice – but just make certain that you are able to access the appropriate statute or rule in class.</p>
