Limited mediation opportunities are available in the prosecutor's office starting at either 5:00 PM or 6:00 PM on select evenings. Students may also have opportunities to observe mediations at other locations such as the Ohio Civil Rights Commission and the Franklin County Domestic Relations Court Mediation Program.
